

香港紅十字會於一九五零年創立，屬於英國紅十字會分會，直到一九九七年，隨香港主權移交，我們成爲中國紅十字會一個享有高度自治的分會。

我們的義工人數由初時只有 100 人，至今已超過 2 萬 2 千人。服務亦由早期的輸血服務、尋人服務、義工招募及特殊教育，發展到現在多元化、跨地域的項目，包括，賑災及備災、急救及健康護理訓練、長者及院友關顧、社區心理支援服務、海外緊急醫療隊、人道教育等。

當中永恆不變的，是我們都力求世上人人都能尊重及保護人的生命和尊嚴，並能自願地以一視同仁的態度施以援手，改善弱勢社群的境況。

The Hong Kong Red Cross (HKRC) was established in 1950 as a branch of the British Red Cross Society. Upon the return of Hong Kong's sovereignty to China in 1997, we have changed our affiliation to become a highly autonomous branch of the Red Cross Society of China.

At the very beginning, we only had 100 volunteers but now the number of volunteers has exceeded 22,000. Our scope of services also expanded from Blood Transfusion, Tracing, Volunteering and Special Education to much more diversified and cross-border projects nowadays including Disaster Relief & Preparedness, First Aid and Health Training, Elderly & Patients Caring, Community-based Psychological Support Service, Emergency Respond Unit, and Humanity Education etc.

Our vision stands still – “We strive for a world in which people respect and protect human life and dignity, and where people are ready to offer impartial and voluntary aid to help improve the lives of vulnerable people.”
